LEASH LAWS

The City of Camarillo requires all dogs to be either fenced in, tied or under leash control of their owners at all times when outdoors. Dogs roaming free are subject to being picked up by Ventura County Animal Regulation, and their owners may have to pay fines. Please keep control of your dog at all times when outside. And please, remember that all dogs must be licensed by Animal Regulation. For more information on the leash law or other animal regulations, call Animal Regulation at 388-4341.

PLEASE SLOW DOWN WHEN DRIVING THRU THE COMMUNITY

Please be careful driving through Fairfield streets. Many children are using them to play and walk during these summer months. Slow down, drive with caution and watch for kids and pets. **Please also remember to stop and yield to oncoming traffic when approaching an intersection. Respect your neighbors and fellow residents and help prevent unnecessary accidents.**



ON THE TRICK-OR-TREAT TRAIL:

A parent or responsible adult should always accompany young children on their neighborhood rounds. If your older children are going alone, plan and review the route that is acceptable to you. Agree on a specific time when they should return home. Only go to homes with a porch light on and never enter a home or car for a treat.

- ◆ Stay in a group and communicate where they will be going.
- ◆ Carry a cell phone for quick communication.
- ◆ Remain on well-lit streets and always use the sidewalk.
- ◆ Never cut across yards or use alleys.
- ◆ Only cross streets as a group and never cross between parked cars or out driveways.

NEIGHBORHOOD TREES

With the new fiscal year, the Board is continuing to focus on trees throughout the community that have caused damage to walkways and driveways and others that are not healthy. The board chose Green Valley Tree Care, Inc., as their vendor to remove 32 trees. 23 of these trees were European sycamores. This species of tree was used extensively in the 1980's and many of them have not grown into the healthy attractive trees that they should have. Many have very poor structure and lose their leaves multiple times a year and with the drought, they have become diseased. All of the replacement tree species were specifically chosen for being non-deciduous and for having non-invasive root systems. This is a big project and will take a few years to complete.
