## FRIENDLY REMINDERS

**Disposal of Christmas trees** – After the holidays, your Christmas tree may be recycled on your yard waste collection day for the two weeks following Christmas. Please remove all tinsel, ornaments, tree stands and any large nails placed in the trunk of the tree. Place whole tree next to your yard waste barrel. *Flocked or fire-proofed trees cannot be recycled. Cut these in half and dispose of them in your refuse barrel.*



**Holiday Decorations** - Please do not put decorations on any common areas maintained by the Association. Also, per the Rules and Regulations, holiday lighting and decorations must be removed within two weeks after the conclusion of said holiday. Please remember to remove your holiday decorations by January 15!

There have been some residential burglaries in Camarillo. Several of these burglaries are close to green belts, barranca, golf course, ravine, or open green spaces. Some homes have alarm systems that were not turned on. Please use the following tips and recommendations.

- ◆ LOCK ALL WINDOWS AND DOORS WHEN LEAVING FOR ANY PERIOD OF TIME
- ◆ DO NOT ANNOUNCE YOUR VACATION PLANS ON SOCIAL MEDIA
- ◆ WHEN LEAVING ON VACATION, USE LIGHT TIMERS OR LEAVE A LIGHT ON
- ◆ INVEST IN SOME TYPE OF HOME SECURITY MEASURE (RING DOORBELL, ARLO, DEFENDER, OR A PROFESSIONAL ALARM COMPANY)
- ◆ LOCK SIDE GATES
- ◆ SENSOR LIGHTS FOR EXTERIOR OF YOUR HOME
- ◆ KEEP YOUR LANDSCAPE TRIMMED AND FREE OF "HIDING SPOTS" FOR CRIMINALS
- ◆ HAVE A TRUSTED FAMILY, FRIEND, OR NEIGHBOR PICK UP NEWSPAPER, PACKAGES AND MAIL WHEN AWAY FROM HOME OR OUT OF TOWN
- ◆ IF YOU SEE A SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE OR PERSON IN YOUR AREA, CALL THE POLICE 805-654-9511 AND GIVE A GOOD DESCRIPTION .... (THIS MAY BE HELPFUL FOR OUR DETECTIVES TO CATCH A CRIMINAL)
